LHI Group: LHI KVG rated "very good" for Sustainability

Rating agency imug rating evaluates LHI Kapitalverwaltungsgesellschaft mbH and three investment products

The LHI Group, through its subsidiary LHI Kapitalverwaltungsgesellschaft mbH, underwent an independent, external sustainability rating at an early stage and received the grade "very good". In addition, two investment products were classified as "ESG Impact" funds and one as an "ESG Strategy" fund. LHI KVG thus already has several products that meet the requirements of Articles 8 and 9 of the Disclosure Regulation.

Overall, the company's rating confirms that 35% of the investment assets under management already meet ESG criteria and 65% of the investment assets are neutral products. LHI KVG does not manage any products that are classified as controversial products by a majority of sustainable investors.

"We are proud of this result. Our business strategy has always been designed for the long term and thus sustainability. The fact that the LHI Group is already a climate-positive company as well as a member of the E.C.O.R.E Initiative and now also has a very good rating result are the consistent steps within the framework of our lived sustainability," says Markus Niedermeier, Managing Director of the LHI Group.
